## Outcome of Metropolitan Region Scheme Amendment 1242/41 Lot 911 Midland Road, Hazelmere

In June 2014, the Western Australian Planning Commission (WAPC) wrote to you on the status of the abovementioned amendment to the Metropolitan Region Scheme, for which you made a submission. I now write to advise that the amendment process is complete.

The WAPC considered the written submissions and the views expressed during the hearings and published its report on submissions. The WAPC recommended that the amendment proceed but with modifications. The amendment was endorsed by the Minister for Planning and His Excellency the Governor, and subsequently laid before each House of Parliament for twelve sitting days as required by statute.

During that time, no notice of motion to disallow the amendment was moved. Therefore the amendment is effective in the Metropolitan Region Scheme on and from 11 September 2014.

A notice advising of the effective date will be published in the *Government Gazette* on Tuesday 21 October 2014.

This now concludes the amendment procedure. The zones and reservations, as depicted in amending plan number 3.2525/1, will now appear in the Metropolitan Region Scheme.
